Eligibility Criteria

General Requirements

The fund is open to the following individuals who has an affiliation with a high school that has a project that will benefit their nominated school such as:

- A high school student
- A high school principal or teacher
- A high school PTA officer

Completed Bluesky High School Application Form with all required documents (incomplete applications will not be considered):

Eligible projects must be about improving and advancing learning through technology or implementing a technological project that'll benefit high school students.

Selection Criteria

Bluesky will consider various criteria factors when reviewing applications and making decisions based upon the following:

1. Applicant's project
2. Applicant's essay
3. Does the application project address one of the following:
 - Promotes the positive impact of technology in various learning activities;
 - Utilizes technology to promote interests in STEM related careers;
 - Utilizes technology to benefit high school students; and/or
 - Applies technology to improve and advance the learning of students.

The Bluesky High School Technology Initiative Committee will review all applications and is subject to Bluesky's discretion and approval. Bluesky will recognize awardees at a Bluesky-sponsored event in July 2019. Recipients of the award will be advised of the specific date, time and location. Recipient attendance is mandatory unless excused in advance for good cause.

At Bluesky's discretion, Bluesky may pay directly to the awardee's high school or to designated store/vendor for the materials, supplies, or equipment.
